- * In ROOT folder, the numbers of files can be recorded are totally limited to 256, which includes the file names is 8 and extended file name is 3. But it is unlimited in the lower folder.

- Remove dead batteries immediately to avoid damage from corrosion.
- When corrosion occurs, wipe the battery compartment immediately with a dry cloth and insert a new battery.

TROUBLE SHOOTING
